Row of 3 houses, late C18th. Rubble with stone slate roof. Each house of one bay. Facade has projecting quoins and sill bands. Windows tripartite, stepped, with plain stone surrounds and square mullions. Except for the right-hand house, the inner light of each window is sashed with glazing bars and the outer lights fixed with glazing bars. The door of the left-hand house is at the right. The doors of the other 2 houses are paired. Each has a plain stone surround with open moulded pediment on shaped brackets. The gables have copings with kneelers. Chimneys on gables and to right of left-hand house.

House, early C19th. Slobbered rubble with stone slate roof. 2 storeys, 2 bays. Windows of 2 lights with square mullions and plain stone surrounds. Each right-hand light is sashed with glazing bars. The left-hand lights are fixed with glazing bars. The door, between bays, has a plain stone surround and a hood of 2 pitched stone slates on square brackets. Chimney between bays.

House, late C18th. Rendered rubble with stone slate roof. 2 storeys. On the ground floor are 2 wide gabled porches, the right-hand one having a chimney on its front wall. Windows have plain stone surrounds. Between the porches is one of one light. At the left is a similar window of sawn stone. At the right is a 3-light window with square mullions. On the 1st floor are similar windows of 3, 4, and 3 lights. Each porch has a door with plain stone surround, the right-hand one having a worn date (1780?) on the lintel. Chimneys at ends of facade and on each side of central 1st floor window. The barn adjoining to the left is altered and is not included in the item.

House, 1719. Sandstone rubble with stone slate roof. 2 storeys, 2 bays with moulded string and cornice. Windows, of 4 lights, have chamfered stone surrounds, square mullions, and a central king mullion. The door, between bays, has an architrave with pulvinated frieze, and '1719' inscribed below the cornice. Chimneys on gables and to right of door.

House, late C18th. Sandstone rubble with stone slate roof. 2 storeys, 2 bays. Windows have plain stone surrounds, formerly with square mullions, now removed. Door, between bays, has plain stone surround and hood of 2 pitched stone slates. Rectangular stone gutter brackets. Chimney to left of door. Farm building at left has 2 doors with plain reveals.

House, late C18th. Coursed sandstone with slate roof. 2 storeys, 4 bays. Windows have plain stone surrounds and square mullions. All tripartite except for the one on the 1st floor of the 2nd bay, above the door, which is a single sash with glazing bars. The outer lights are fixed with glazing bars, except for the left-hand light of the 1st floor window of bay 3, which is blocked with painted glazing bars. The door has a plain stone surround and a moulded open pediment on shaped brackets. Chimneys on right-hand gable and to left of right-hand bay.
