

## LICENSING ACT 2003 SECTION 51 NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE

The **LICENSING AUTHORITY** of Ribble Valley Borough Council, Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA

HEREBY GIVE NOTICE THAT **LANCASHIRE CONSTABULARY** have applied to Ribble Valley Borough Council Licensing Authority on 7<sup>th</sup> day of OCTOBER 2011, for the review of the Premises Licence in respect of premises known as **THE VICTORIA HOTEL**, **1 MARKET PLACE**, **CLITHEROE BB7 2BZ** under the Licensing Act 2003 on the grounds that as a Responsible Authority, Lancashire Constabulary do not consider the premises to be promoting the Licensing Objective of the Protection of Children from Harm.

Under **Section 158** of the **Licensing Act 2003** it is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction is up to £5000 (level 5 on the standard scale).
