NOTICE OF DETERMINATION IN RESPECT OF A HEARING

TO DETERMINE AN APPLICATION BY BOLTON-BY-BOWLAND VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE IN RESPECT OF

BOLTON BY BOWLAND VILLAGE HALL

The Sub-Committee met to determine the application by Bolton-by-Bowland Village Hall Committee to vary the premises licence as follows:

- 1. To permit regulated entertainment in the form of plays, films and sporting events all indoors only.
- 2. To authorise the supply of alcohol on the premises and late night refreshments indoors.
- 3. To disapply the mandatory condition relating to the requirement for a designated premises supervisor.
- 4. To reduce the hours for regulated entertainment in the form of live music, recorded music, performance of dance and anything within a similar description to (e), (f) and (g).
- 5. To permit licensable activities to take place on a Sunday.

The Licensing Sub-Committee gave careful consideration to the report of the Chief Executive and to representations both written and verbal, the Licensing Act 2003, the licensing objectives, the relevant regulations made under the Act and the Council's licensing policy and determined the application will be granted subject to the following amendments:

- The supply of alcohol will crease 30 minutes before the closing time of the premises.
- The additional condition in Section M(b) will be amended to read 'keep all doors and windows closed'.
- An additional condition will be added to require that 'when the supply of alcohol takes place
 the supervising member of the Committee should display a form of identification and that all
 Members of the Committee will undertake training to enable them to ensure that the
 conditions of the licence are met'.
