## 1 PURPOSE

1.1 To consider requests for additional funding from Health and Housing Committee.

## 2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Committees manage their services within the agreed budget. Where new schemes or additional spending pressures arise during the year they can request this Committee to provide additional funding (supplementary estimates).
- 3 HEALTH AND HOUSING COMMITTEE 17 SEPTEMBER 2009
- 3.1 Members considered a request for additional funding to extend the provision of dog waste bins and emptying over a 5 year rolling programme.
- 3.2 The extra funding required would be to purchase the bins, employ a dedicated cleansing operative and purchase a suitable vehicle to collect and dispose of all dog waste arising. This totalled set up costs of £17,300 and annual costs of £25,100 (£22,550 in the first year).
- 3.3 Health and Housing Committee agreed to extend the service in principle and referred the request for extra funding to this Committee.
- 3.4 Members expressed some concern that no alternative methods for implementing such an extension of the service had been put forward.
- 4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS
- 4.1 If approved, set up costs could be considered to be of a capital nature and thus would be added to the Council's capital programme. The annual costs of £25,100 would need to be incorporated into the revenue budget.
- 5 RECOMMENDED THAT COMMITTEE
- 5.1 Consider this request from Health and Housing Committee for additional funding.
