1 PURPOSE OF REPORT
1.1 To present the recommendations of the working group in relation to the allocation of grants under Individual Sporting Excellence, Individual Arts Excellence and Recreation/Culture.

### 1.2 Relevance to the Council Aims / Ambitions

- Principle Aim - To be a well-managed council, providing efficient and responsive services, based on identified customer needs.
- Council Ambitions -- To make people's lives safer and healthier and, more specifically, to increase opportunities for people to access cultural activities and improve outcomes for children and young people.


## 2 BACKGROUND

2.1 The Council's Sporting Excellence Grants seek to assist many talented sportsmen and women in their chosen sport, helping towards the expenses associated with competition, training and equipment.
2.2 Arts Excellence awards are a new addition, mirroring the support given through sporting excellence.
2.3 The purpose of Recreation/Culture grants is to provide voluntary organisations with support for events/projects that enhance recreation and cultural provision.

## 3 ISSUES

The number of applications across all three categories was down on last year. This is owing, in part, to a lack of publicity because of the initial uncertainty on the Council's financial position. This is particularly the case for Arts Excellence grant applications. To help resolve this we have carried out some additional publicity to help generate applications. This does mean, however, that we are unable to present any recommendations with this report, so this will be presented at Committee for approval.

4 RISK ASSESSMENT
Approval of this report may have the following implications:

- Resources - There is a sum of $£ 31,796$ available within the Recreation/Culture Grants fund (2010/11 allocation plus balance carried forward, and $£ 3,280$ transferred to Arts Excellence). There is also an additional $£ 7,000$ from a project by Wiswell Parish Council that will not be going ahead. It is proposed that this should be
rounded down to $£ 37,000$ with the remainder being transferred to the Ribble Valley in Bloom / Christmas Lights Fund (this would mean there would be $£ 2,455$ available to allocate). There is $£ 3,280$ available for Sports and Arts excellence grants respectively.
- Technical, Environmental and Legal - none
- Political - none
- Reputation - the grants programme is well received within the community, and gives the Council a platform to dernonstrate its support for the voluntary sector and young people.


## 5 RECOMMENDED THAT COMMITTEE
