2.1 On 17 September 2013, Committee approved the Scheme of Delegation of Decision Making and Functions (the "**Scheme**") in readiness for the Act coming into force on 1 October 2013.

The revised proposed wording is clearer and more accurately reflects the procedure to be followed.
