#### LICENSING HEARING - TAXIS

### Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence and Private Hire Driver's Licence

The Sub-Committee received a report of the Chief Executive, relating to an application for the grant of a hackney carriage driver's licence and private hire driver's licence for an individual, together with details of an endorsement of penalty points on the applicant's driving licence issued by the DVLA. The Sub-Committee heard from the applicant with regard to the circumstances of the offence giving rise to the endorsement and information about the applicant's prior driving history.

Having taken into account the submissions and the circumstances, the Sub-Committee determined that the applicant was not a fit and proper person to hold a hackney carriage driver's licence and a private hire driver's licence.

# RESOLVED: That the application be refused.

# Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence

The Sub-Committee received a report of the Chief Executive relating to an application by an individual for a hackney carriage driver's licence. Due to a lack of clear information from the applicant and the DVLA with regard to the applicant's driving history, the Sub-Committee determined adjournment of the application to obtain further information was the approach that was fair for all parties.

## Private Hire Driver's Licence

The Sub-Committee received a report of the Chief Executive relating to a complaint received about the conduct of a private hire driver. Having received new information at the hearing, the Sub-Committee determined that it was in the interests of fairness to all parties to adjourn the matter for proper consideration of the new information.
