REVIEW OF POLITICAL BALANCE FOR MUNICIPAL YEAR 2018/2019 ARISING FROM THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILLORS FROM THE CONSERVATIVE GROUP

1 PURPOSE
1.1 To revise the Council's current Committee arrangements following a review of the political balance calculation.
1.2 Relevance to the Council's objectives and priorities:

- Council's Objectives - Whilst the Council's Committee arrangements do not contribute directly to the achievement of the Council's objectives, they set the framework for the Council's decision making processes.
- Other considerations - The Council decided under the provisions of the Local Government Act 2000, after consultation with the electorate, to retain its Committee arrangements rather than opt for an executive form of governance. This decision has been reconsidered and confirmed by the Policy and Finance Committee.

2 BACKGROUND
2.1 The basis of the Council's present Committee structure was approved by the Policy and Finance Committee at its meeting on 3 April 2008.
2.2 The number of seats on each Committee and the allocation of these seats are calculated in accordance with the political balance provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989.
2.3 The Council also determines the allocation of Committee seats to the Labour Councillor who, as one member, does not constitute a political group.
2.4 The political balance was recalculated and approved at Council on 10 July 2018 after three Councillors resigned from the Conservative Group and formed a group called the Democratic Conservatives.

3 ISSUES
3.1 Two members of the Council have resigned from the Conservative group and joined the political group called the Democratic Conservatives. This means that the overall political balance of the Council has changed and must therefore be recalculated to take this into account.
3.2 The recalculation of seats is attached at Appendix $A$.
3.3 The new membership on Committees following the recalculation is attached at Appendix B.
3.4 The Representatives on Outside Bodies have also been reviewed by the Leader of the Conservative group and amendments suggested to reflect the change in political group membership as attached at Appendix C.
3.5 The Council appointed 13 Councillors to represent the Council on the Parish Council Liaison Committee in May 2018. The representation was 11 Conservatives and 2 Liberal Democrats. It is suggested (based on political balance) that the proportion be amended to 10 Conservatives, 1 Liberal Democrat and 2 Democratic Conservatives.
