

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

DIVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS Nos.12 & 22 WISWELL (PARTS)

This order is made by Ribble Valley Borough Council (the Authority) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (the 1980 Act) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any expenses, which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public. All limitations will be provided or modified so that they comply with BS 5907:2006

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Wiswell Moorhouses Farm, Clerk Hill Road, Wiswell shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up as from the date the Authority certifies that all work to bring the footpaths, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out.
- 2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situated at Wiswell Moorhouses Farm, Clerk Hill Road, Wiswell described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.



SCHEDULE

PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

Footpath No. 12.

From Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7568 3707, Point A on the Order Plan in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 189 metres, to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7553 3720 Point B on the Order Plan, then in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 89 metres, to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7546 3725 Point H on the Order Plan a total distance of 278 metres. The existing path is shown by a bold line on the Order Plan and marked A – B – H.

Footpath No. 22.

From Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7568 3707, Point A on the Order Plan in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 249 metres, to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7543 3715 Point C on the Order Plan. The existing path is shown by a bold line on the Order Plan and marked A-C.

PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Footpath No. 12.

The new length of path to be created being 2 metres wide from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7572 3712, Point D on the Order Plan in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7572 3712, Point E on the Order Plan, then in generally north westerly direction for approximately 41 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7568 3714 Point F on the Order Plan and then in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 143 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7557 3722 Point G on the Order Plan, and then in a west north westerly direction for approximately 114 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7546 3725, Point H on the Order Plan, a total distance of approximately 304 metres. The new path is shown by a bold dashed line on the Order Plan and marked D - E - F - G - H.

Footpath No. 22.

The new length of path to be created being 2 metres wide from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7543 3712, Point C on the Order Plan in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 128 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7553 3720, Point B on the Order Plan, then in generally north easterly direction for approximately 46 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SD 7557 3722 Point G on the Order Plan, a total distance of approximately 174 metres. The new path is shown by a bold dashed line on the Order Plan and marked C - B - G.
