Re Development Plan Document 2008-2028

My main concern is the proposed building on the site known as WADDELL VIEW. A conservation study was previously carried out and it found it to be of considerable importance, last week Cuckoo (endangered species) were seen looking for nest-sites. Ancient trees and mature Ledges border all round the site. The new houses now complete at Low Moor are only a short distance away - in view, soon there will be no gaps, all one large housing estate.

Approx 2000 car journeys along Waddington Road some of which will be Self Employed tradesmen Vans will exacerbate this difficult stretch; diversions are not feasible on narrow lanes with Bridge restrictions. The Bridge is 3.5m and regularly flooded.

Chilthorne is noted for being one of the worst areas in the COUNTRY for AIR POLLUTION. I suffer with breathing problems, body all working normally - only answer from Hospital - BAD AIR.

Extra traffic since previous surveys, On line Shopping Delivery Vans. New Buses larger and longer than those they replace, The Railway road / Waddington road junction a frequent bottle neck under Bridge (prone to flooding)

on never ever use large intrusive parking -  
narrows the usable road space.

A bus route down Kerriemoor Road is definately  
not feasible. Access to Sheltered Housing required  
at all times, cars parked right on road junctions

Who compensates the farmers who use the  
land for cattle and sheep grazing??

Back Common - (Border of Waddow View for  
those who do it know) should be the boundary for  
Clitheroe Town at this point. This route is 1000 years old

I visited the Level D. area last week to view  
the Document -

VERY BADLY Presented - 2" thick and no INDEX

A planning staff member came to discuss my  
questions, but did NOT KNOW where  
Waddow View and Waddington road were.  
Too many councillors do not have any local  
knowledge of our area - town and environs.

They can and do out vote the town Councillors  
to the detriment of Clitheroe which is UNIQUE

The small market town mage must be preserved  
and not urbanised - go to Blackpool if you want to see

at the expense of our precious green spaces
