I am writing to you to strongly object to further housing developments in particular to the potential widening of the current settlement boundaries for Highmoor Park.

Whilst I appreciate that our future population expansion, requires additional housing, and that I was lucky enough as a current resident on Highmoor Park that things have to change and the town has needed to expand, however there does become a point when you hit saturation point. I strong believe that we are now at this point.
