a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note

All staff involved in the sale of alcohol will be trained in the licensing objectives to reduce crime and disorder, upkeep public safety, prevent public nuisance and protect children from harm. Training will be documented for the licensing officer, and all staff will have refresher training every 12 months.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV shall be installed with clear signage to make customers aware - it will record 24 hours a day, and be of evidential quality. Recordings will be retained for 31 days, and be made available on request to the relevant authorities. The premises is alarmed & will send an alert to call the police in the event of any out of hours intrusions.

We will also keep an incident register of any ejections or unpleasant experiences if they arise.

c) Public safety

Appropriate fire safety measures (clear signage, fire extinguishers on each floor, multiple exits where possible) will be implemented by a qualified installer. No exits will be blocked and electrical equipment will be PAT tested when needed.

Any sharp/potentially dangerous products (bottle openers, kitchen knives etc) will only be sold to to customers aged 18+, who are of sound of mind - we will assess this on a case-by-case basis at time of sale.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Due to the nature of the shop, noise pollution will be at a minimum - There will be no live performances of any kind, and all customers will leave the building at 18:30. There will be no odours emanating from the building as we will only be providing cold food such as cheese and cured meat. Litter will be placed in a covered bin store in the rear garden, and refuse sorting will not take place outside between 10pm and 8am. The front entrance and rear area of the the premises will be kept clean and free from litter and obstacles, and signage will not be placed in areas that block public walkways.

All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises will be made in sealed containers.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will enforce a strict 'Challenge 25' policy to purchase alcohol - any person who appears under the age of 25 will be required to provide either a valid passport or driving license, to prove they are over 18. All staff will be trained and documented regarding this policy with refresher training available.

Children under the age of 16 will be required to be accompanied by an adult.

 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

In order to establish the applicant's right to work, the check will need to indicate that the applicant is allowed to work in the United Kingdom and is not subject to a condition preventing them from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.

An online check will not be possible in all circumstances because not all applicants will have an immigration status that can be shared digitally. The Home Office online right to work checking service sets out what information and/or documentation applicants will need in order to access the service.

Applicants who are unable to obtain a share code from the service should submit copies of documents as set out above.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.






General Shopfloor plan for licencing June 2025


Outdoor courtyard seating area plan for licencing June 2025
