

RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL
SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (TCPA 1847)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (2025-9)

1. Ribble Valley Borough Council gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being

- The length of Wesleyan Row in the Town Centre of Clitheroe extending from its junction with Parson Lane to the Trinity Methodist Church and Community Hub_____
- The length of Parson Lane in the Town Centre of Clitheroe extending from the junction with Wesleyan Row to the junction with Station Road_____
- The length of Station Road in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from the junction with Parson Lane to the junction with King Lane_____
- The length of King Lane in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from the junction with Station Road to the junction with King Lane/Market Place_____
- The length of Market Place in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from the junction with King Lane to the junction with Wellgate/York Street_____
- The length of Wellgate in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from the junction with Market Place/York Street to the junction with Lowergate/Shawbridge Street_____
- The length of Lowergate in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from its junction with Wellgate/Shawbridge Street to its junction with Moor Lane.
- The length of Moor Lane in the Town Centre of Clitheroe from its junction with Lowergate to its junction with Castle Gate_____

And shown coloured red on the plan attached to this Order.

2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highway specified in paragraph 1 during the following event, Clitheroe Torchlight Procession

3. The Order shall come into operation at 06.00pm on Saturday 11 October 2025 and will remain in force until 09.00pm on Saturday 11 October 2025.

4. While the Order is in operation, traffic including bicycle and pedestrian movement along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) between 06.00pm and 09.00pm on Saturday 11 October 2025.

- 5.All restrictions will be signed (and staffed) and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 6.Nothing in the Order will apply to:
- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer.
 - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which the Order applies.
- 7.Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order.
- 8.All constables are directed to enforce the provision of this Order.
- 9.The promoters of the event are Clitheroe Chamber of Trade
- 10.For further information about the proposed restrictions, or the event [or the alternative route] please contact Head of Engineering Services, Ribble Valley Borough Council Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire, BB7 2RA between the hours of Monday to Fridays (excluding bank holidays and public holidays)
