

RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL
SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (TCPA 1847)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (2025-10)

1. Ribble Valley Borough Council gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being

- The length of Calder Avenue in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from its junction with Berry Lane to the Civic Hall _____
- The length of Derby Road in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from its junction with Berry Lane to its junction with Kestor Lane _____
- The length of Berry Lane in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from the junction with King Street to its junction with Derby Road _____
- The length of Market Place in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from the junction with King Street to its junction with Kestor Lane _____
- The length of Kestor Lane in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from the junction with Market Place to its junction with Derby Road _____

2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highway specified in paragraph 1 during the following event, the Longridge Remembrance Sunday Parade.

3. The Order shall come into operation at 08.30am on Sunday 9 November 2025 and will remain in force until 02.00pm on Sunday 9 November 2025.

4. While the Order is in operation, traffic including bicycle and pedestrian movement along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) between 08.30 am and 02.00pm

5. All restrictions will be signed (and staffed) and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer.
- Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which the Order applies.

7. Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order.

8. All constables are directed to enforce the provision of this Order.

9. The promoter of the event is Longridge Town Council.

10.
