Clitheroe Market - Trader Code of Conduct

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to protect and enhance the Market's reputation as a vibrant, attractive and safe environment for the public, traders, employees and council staff.

This Code applies to all market traders, licence holders and their employees.

Complaints about market trader conduct should be reported to the Market Officer on clitheroemarket@ribblevalley.gov.uk / 01200 443012

Trader Conduct Expectations:

- 1. Traders must treat all customers, other market traders, council representatives and visitors to the market with respect at all times.
- 2. Traders shall not act in a manner which is abusive or aggressive or which makes anyone feel uncomfortable to be on the market.
 - Verbal abuse, bad language, physical aggression, shouting or intimidating behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 3. Discrimination or any form of intolerance based on age, race, gender, disability, marital status, maternity/pregnancy, religion/belief or sexual orientation will also not be tolerated.
- 4. Traders shall only occupy stalls, pitches and cabins that they have paid to use.
- 5. Traders shall not do anything that interferes with a display, stall, pitch, cabin of any other trader.
