

Advisory Note Regarding Inspector's Site Visit and Parking Arrangements – Langho

Notes as follows:

- Photo Viewpoint 1 – Langho railway station. Park nearby in the village.
- Photo Viewpoint 2 – Public footpath on site. Park in the village, nearby.
- Photo Viewpoint 3 – Public footpath on site. Park in the village, nearby.
- Photo Viewpoint 4 – Possible to drive down the farm track to the viewpoint, then proceed further on towards farm to turn around.
- Photo Viewpoint 5 – Drive along Whitehalgh Lane and park on private driveway in front of stone gateposts as there is sufficient width for vehicles to get past on the bellmouth or the adjacent wide grass verge (west side of the road). From there, walk along footpath to viewpoint.
- Photo Viewpoint 6 – Park on the residential road (Moorland Road).
- Photo Viewpoint 7 – Park in residential road, Hollies Road in Wilpshire, close to public footpath off the Whalley Road and walk downhill to Viewpoint 7.
- Photo Viewpoint 8 – Is on the Ribble Valley Jubilee Trail public footpath. Access to this is via a public footpath from the Whalley Road (A666). Park on the residential road Hollies Road within the settlement of Wilpshire, and from there, take the path from the settlement up to the moor for Viewpoint 8.
- Photo Viewpoint 9 – Footpath leading off unclassified road. Can park on the grass verge of the Whalley Old Road.
- Photo Viewpoint 10 – Viewpoint on public footpath. Inspector can park on wide grass verge on the highway at Dinckley.
- Photo Viewpoint 11 – Viewpoint on the footpath is adjacent to the road and there is an area of hardstanding by 2 gates where parking is available off the road.
